

Klein Collins Band Association Meeting Notes

September 9, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7pm by Marcie Langenberg. Introductions and welcome remarks were given. There were 23 members present.

The reading of the July Planning meeting was completed; to be noted, it was voted on by the KCBA Board to utilize approx \$20K of the unrestricted net assets from the KCBA account to provide additional services/products to the Band in 2013-2014. Over the course of the summer (June-July) KCBA has volunteered 155 hours and in August we have captured 819 volunteer hours. YTD: 974 hours.

- ❖ Treasurer – as of Sept 8, 2013 we have \$90K in the bank
- ❖ Budget Report – we have approx 20 families that have not completed their portion of the Band Fees, which has created a deficit of approx \$15K; Debbie is updating the roster and will begin making collection calls and emails.
- ❖ Governance – Maryjane will be assisting each committee with creating or updating the process binders following marching season.
- ❖ Vice-President – all committees are up and running, volunteer support has been really good
- ❖ President
 - Committee Reports – Committee members are asked to keep track of their volunteer hours and the names of the parents that volunteers as well
 - Chaperones – have lots of new parents helping out
 - Feed the Band – CASH only unless paying for all game day meals
 - Football program – cost this year is \$6, all KISD have to vote on the price and KC was out voted 3 to 1 on raising the price from 2012's \$5 cost
 - Props – need help painting barrier walls and the other props will be delivered by beginning of October; some assembly required
 - Uniforms – first cleaning is scheduled for September 12th
 - Donations – KCBA received the 2012-2013 Kona Ice donation check in the amount of \$244.60

Old Business

- Feedback from the Band Picnic- everyone loved that the band marched down the center aisle and the slide show was a success. Timing on the food was not optimal; additionally more food was served than was actually ordered, so need to find a control distribution to those that have actually paid for the meal.
- KCBA is required to provide to the District each year a report of our officers, bylaws, and financial records; that has been completed for the 2013-2014 school year

New Business

- Debbie Rittenhouse reported on the annual audit of the KCBA's financial records. Financial records are in good standing. Copy of report is available by contacting Debbie Rittenhouse or Marcie Langenberg
- Tonya Farmer, Maryjane Lawrence and Debbie Rittenhouse will attend the KISD Financial Workshop on September 16, 2013.
- KCBA is still looking for some volunteers to help with the following open Positions: Webmaster & Spirit Sales: decals & signs. We need to find someone to start working on maintaining the website other than Marcie and/or Jeff Teter (Senior parents). Julie Morgan said that she could probably fold the spirit

decals/signs into the rest of Spirit sales for next year. We need to find a secure location to store the Spirit sales inventory other than a parent's house.

Band Director's Report

- Security measures will be heightened for game at SISD due to past year's issues and recent events.
- Lonestar Marching Contest – we will perform between 9am and 12noon. Hopefully we will progress to the Finals, however in the event that we do not, the Band will stay to watch the finals. We have not taken this opportunity in the past, so to continue to develop our program we need to watch bands that are performing at these higher levels.
- 8th grade Night with the Band is September 27th; Band Student Leadership is planning more activities this year including a party for the 8th graders on Sept 13 from 5-7 in the Band Hall.
